

HOW TO CREATE A UNIQUE STUDENT IDENTIFIER (USI)


STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS TO SET UP AN USI.

All accredited VET Training and Assessments will require you to nominate your USI to the Registered Training Organisation (RTO). You can set up your USI yourself, or you can get Your Licence to set it up on your behalf.




STEP 4

In this step you will need to select a form of identification and input the necessary details.




STEP 5
